EXECUTIVE ORDER ON THE CONSOLIDATION OF  
HUMAN RESOURCE PERSONNEL

**WHEREAS**, the State of Wyoming is facing her greatest fiscal challenge since statehood and is called upon to make significant budget cuts; and

**WHEREAS**, the State must prepare now for these challenges and the quicker we act, the greater ability the State will have to minimize the impact on people; and

**WHEREAS**, thoughtfully reducing budgets for all state agencies, boards, and commissions is the first step to address this impending crisis; and

**WHEREAS**, Wyo. Stat Ann. § 9-2-1002(b) allows the Department of Administration and Information (Department) to assist the Governor in discharging his duties as chief executive and administrative officer of the executive branch of the government, and specifically mandates that the Governor, through the Department, shall coordinate, consolidate, and provide services which are used by more than one agency, board, or commission and promote economy and efficiency in government; and

**WHEREAS**, the consolidation of human resources personnel will result in significant cost savings and promote efficiency in government.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Constitution and by the laws of the State of Wyoming, I, Mark Gordon, do hereby order and direct:

1. The Director of the Department of Administration and Information to coordinate the immediate consolidation of all human resources personnel to be housed under the Department.
2. The Department, at the direction of the Governor, to mandate the process and procedure for the consolidation of all state human resources personnel.

This Executive Order is effective July 10, 2020.
